Why Might You Consider Adding an Embedded Librarian to Your Course

- Including an embedded librarian in your course is very helpful in classes where there are multiple research components or in classes where you think students might need a little extra research support (beyond just the one-shot information literacy instruction).
- An embedded librarian is able to provide increased research support to your students for the **entire semester**.
- An embedded librarian can be added to any course, regardless of modality.

Some of the Services Embedded Librarians Can Provide

- Multiple library instruction sessions throughout the semester via Zoom, video tutorials, or in-person.
- Customized content geared towards specific assignments that can be pushed out to students at the time they need it.
- Individualized research paper consultations via Zoom or in-person.
- Creation of a library research module in your Canvas course that includes relevant content and links for students.
- Embedded librarian “office hours,” virtually or in-person.
- Monitoring of a library and research-related discussion forum in Canvas where students are able to get their questions answered.
- Design and grading of research-focused assignments such as annotated bibliographies or research plans.
