

## How to find a masters thesis in the library catalog:

The library currently houses theses from the Masters of Humanities program here at Wilson. If you are a student or faculty member looking for a thesis from previous years to use as an example or template for your own work, here is how you find them.

You can find theses by searching the library catalog, Koha: <https://wilson.bywatersolutions.com/>

If you know the title or author for the thesis you are looking for, you can simply type it in the search box.

If you would like to see all of the master's theses, type "theses" into the search box. This will give you a list of all the theses we have currently processed and made available to view.

As you scroll through the list, you will see a small link that says "Available in PDF format."
