

### 11th Amendment

- Limits lawsuits against the states

### 12th Amendment

- Changes the procedure for electing President and Vice-President

### 13th Amendment

- Bans slavery and forced labor (except as punishment)

### 14th Amendment

- -made all people born in United States citizens
- -guaranteed due process and equal protection of the law to all Americans

### 15th Amendment

- All male citizens could vote regardless of race (universal male suffrage)

### 16th Amendment

- Allows the federal government to levy a national income tax

### 17th Amendment

- Establishes the direct election of Senators

### 18th Amendment

- Prohibition of alcohol

## 12-Constitutional Amendments

### 19th Amendment

- Women gained the right to vote (universal female suffrage)

### 20th Amendment

- Changes the beginning of the Presidential and Congressional terms from March 4th to January 2nd

### 21st Amendment

- Repealed prohibition

### 22nd Amendment

- Established a two-term limit for the Presidency

### 23rd Amendment

- Gives residents of Washington, DC the right to vote in national elections

### 24th Amendment

- Abolishes the use of poll taxes in voting

### 25th Amendment

- Defines the line of succession for the Presidency

### 26th Amendment

- Lowered to voting age to 18

### 27th Amendment

- Limits Congressional pay raises until the beginning of the next term
