WHO?: Seniors Only

WHY?: To beautify the campus

To build school spirit

To create a senior tradition

COST: \$20 –does not include parking permit or paint

***Please note that allotted parking spots are given on a first-come, first-served basis.**

- Step 1: Follow achs.stuco on Instagram for any changes/ announcements
- Step 2: Pick up applications beginning **August 7th**, or print one from your Senior Services Canvas page.
- Step 3: Return packet to the front office before **September 4th** to Ms. Woods or Ms. Stolt. A sale date will be announced. **Money for parking spots and painting privileges will not be refunded, even if we move to Plan C.**
- Step 4: Ms. Stolt will schedule a day with you to paint your spot. Please be flexible as we will still have to follow state guidelines, and many of these days will be later than usual. These are subject to change due to any decisions regarding school. **When you are scheduled to paint, you will be limited to 2 extra helpers, and all of you will be expected to wear a mask and maintain social distancing as required by the state. If you do not comply with the state's guidelines, you will be asked to leave, and will not be allowed to continue painting your spot.**

What you need:

- A check for \$20 made payable to ACHS or cash. Painted spots are \$20 extra to help with the cost of supplies and painting over them at the end of the year.
- The completed application for the permit (see attached)
- A signed copy of the Reserved Painted Parking Space Contract (attached)
- A copy of the design for your parking spot **MUST** be attached or drawn on the back of the contract and must be approved prior to painting; We will keep this, so make a copy for yourself.

*All designs must be completed on the Senior Parking Design Request form and returned to the front office for approval by the Assistant Principals. Your design should be clearly drawn on this form and must include the colors you will be using in your parking space.

*Once your design has been reviewed, you will receive an email or call letting you know if it is **unacceptable** or if any changes need to be made.

*The design may not exceed the parking space outline, and it must be **school appropriate** and adhere to the following guidelines.

Paint Requirements

- Paint Options (paint can only be **water-based exterior latex**: no spray paint or airbrush)
- You will provide your own paint (Consider sharing with others.)

Prohibited Designs:

- No offensive language, pictures, or symbols.
- No negative or rude language (Be nice).
- No “gang-style tagging.”
- No double entendres (Double meanings).
- No Images that are trademarked or subject to copyright (Disney characters, etc)
- You may use YOUR NAME. If you want to use a nickname it must be approved. (A boyfriend’s or girlfriend’s name is NOT allowed.)
- Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration.
Disciplinary action may be taken & you may forfeit your right to a parking space and /or the privilege of parking on campus.

PAINTING DAYS:

To be announced based on the decisions relating to the school year. Please be flexible as the days available are limited. Please pay close attention to achs.stuco on Instagram and school announcements made to the public and through the all-call system. **DO NOT PAINT OUTSIDE YOUR SCHEDULED TIME!!! IN ORDER TO OFFER THIS OPPORTUNITY WE MUST MEET GUIDELINES.** You may forfeit your spot and your design will be painted over. This is for safety reasons.

IF YOU NEED MORE TIME, YOU MUST TALK TO ONE OF THE STUDENT COUNCIL SPONSORS TO ARRANGE SUPERVISION. IF YOU PAINT OUTSIDE OF THE GIVEN HOURS YOUR SPOT WILL BE PAINTED OVER AT ADMINISTRATION’S DISCRETION.

What you need: (Again, please consider sharing.)

- Your copy of your approved design
- Sunscreen. Lots of it. Also, a hat. We have done this for several years now. Trust us. Sunscreen.
- Painters tape, tarps, or plastic sheeting, something to block off the rest of the parking spot with so paint is only on the designated block.
- An old towel or scrub brush to clean up an area if you make a mistake or spill paint.
- A bucket for water to clean up brushes or any mistakes. (Some are provided)
- Paintbrushes, paint rollers, paint, or painter’s tape and any other supplies you may need.

Once more, you may only paint during designated times. If you paint without designated supervision, your spot will be painted over.

I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot:

- I understand that my design may be deemed unacceptable, at the discretion of administration for any reason. I will be given one chance to change my design, or I will forfeit my spot.
- **I understand that my guests and I must wear a mask and maintain social distancing as required by the state.**
- Upon purchasing my parking spot I will only use water- based exterior latex paint.
- I understand that I must check -in with Ms. Stolt in front of the building before I begin to paint. (You must confirm your parking spot.)
- **I understand that I must paint my spot during the designated times or the spot will be painted over.** I may request extra, supervised time from a student council sponsor.
- I know I am not allowed to use spray paint or airbrush.
- I will only paint within the marked parking space that is drawn for me.
- I know I have to bring my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my spot.
- I will never park in another parking space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space.
- I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines in my parking space.
- I understand that my painted design must be completed by the first day of school, whenever that is.
- If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my parking spot will be taken away and will be painted over, and I will not receive a refund.
- If I park in someone else's painted parking spot, I will receive disciplinary action.
